Arrive Alive: Speeding

Recent Transportation Data

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the top reason for traffic collisions & fatalities is driving too fast for the road conditions.

The National Safety Council reported that in 2021:

- Speeding was a factor in 29% of all traffic fatalities, killing a total of 11,258 people. That's an average of over 30 people per day.
- The total number of fatal motor-vehicle crashes attributable to speeding was 10,136.
- The proportion of speeding-related crashes to all fatal crashes decreased as the age of the driver increased.
- The proportion of female drivers who were speeding is smaller than male drivers across all age groups.
