## Mid-Ohio Valley

Garden Tour of Julia-Ann Historic District & Lunch at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Deli

Saturday, June 4

**Depart 9:00 AM**

Julia-Ann Square Historic District was built by many prominent West Virginians and was an important center in West Virginia early history. The district is the largest and oldest historic district in West Virginia. Julia-Ann Square is a community of approximately 126 homes surrounded by the city of Parkersburg and includes some of the finest examples of Victorian architecture in the state. The majority of the district's structures are in the Second Empire, 19th century eclectic and Queen Anne styles, and date from c. 1850 to 1910. We will be touring 8 gardens of homes in this area, with lunch (on your own) at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Deli.

## Metro Valley

Charleston The Governor's Mansion, State Capitol, & Cultural Center

Thursday, June 9

**Depart 8:00 AM**

The Metro Valley is home to 30% of the population of West Virginia and it includes some of the most diverse and culturally active areas in the state. The present Capitol took eight years to complete at a cost of just under \$10 million. It was constructed in three stages. At 293 feet, the gold-leafed dome of main capitol building stands five feet higher than the U.S. Capitol dome in Washington, DC. Next door the stately Executive Mansion overlooks the Kanawha River and is home to the Governor and First Family. This 30-room Georgian Revival structure was completed in 1925. The mission of the West Virginia Division of Culture and History is to identify, preserve, protect, promote and present the ideas, arts and artifacts of West Virginia's heritage, building pride in our past accomplishments and confidence in our future. The Cultural Center is an amazing, unique way to do just that!
